## Holocaust Survivors

### Visit Pope

A New York-based organization brought a group of Jewish Holocaust survivors to visit Benedict XVI. They wanted to personally thank the Pope for the Church's intervention in saving their lives during the war.

The *Pave the Way* foundation brought the group to visit the German Pontiff on June 18. It is just one initiative the foundation has undertaken to clear up misunderstandings about the Church and its role during the Holocaust.

## Presbyterians Relax Ban on Gay Clergy

Presbyterian delegates reopened the door to ordaining gays and lesbians.

The General Assembly, of the Louisville based Church, voted 374-325 to establish a new official interpretation of the church constitution that immediately allows for the ordination of ministers even if they don't live by all the requirements of the constitution.

The assembly meeting in San Jose, California, voted 380-325 to repeal the ban on gay ordination entirely. This starts a year-long round of ratification votes in regional governing bodies. (In the past dozen years, two previous attempts have been rejected.)

On the issues of gay ordination, the assembly took the unprecedented step of allowing candidates for ministry to depart in practice, not just in belief, from aspects of the constitution. This does not require ratification and now becomes church law.

The constitution of the Presbyterian Church allows the ordination of only those who are living in celibacy as a single or in a faithful, heterosexual marriage.

## *"Slate" Hijacks Virgin Mary in Muslim Story*

On June 10, the *Wall Street Journal* ran a story about Muslim women in France who have lost their virginity and have then elected to have their hymens surgically reattached; Muslim men expect their brides to be virgins and do not look kindly on those who are not. The next day, the *New York Times* ran a similar story. It was followed the same day by an opinion piece about the two news stories written by *Slate* correspondent William Saletan.

On the home page of *Slate's* website, Saletan's column is flagged by a picture of the Immaculate Heart of Mary; below the photo is the inscription, "A Defense of Virginity-Restoration Surgery."

Catholic League president Bill Donohue commented on what happened:

"Once again, in a story that has absolutely nothing to do with Roman Catholicism, we see a gratuitous attack on Catholics. Are there not suitable Muslim photos that *Slate* could use to draw attention to Saletan's article? The fact that they didn't choose Islamic iconography suggests not a lack of interest, but will: They don't have the guts to offend Muslims."

## Catholic College Sponsors Panel Focusing on Homosexual Couples

In June, Boston College hosted and sponsored "*Love Across Boundaries*", a panel discussion with couples who focus on their interracial, interfaith and same-sex love stories. Featured participants included the Assistant Dean of Harvard College and his homosexual partner.

A representative of the Catholic Action League stated: "**No reasonable person could be expected to believe that the Catholic Church is serious in its opposition to abortion and same-sex marriage as long as Catholic institutions publicly affirm homosexual relationships and prominently showcase pro-abortion political figures.**"

### Archbishop Joseph Naumann

Topeka, KS - Archbishop Joseph F. Naumann has told Kansas Gov. Kathleen Sebelius to refrain from presenting herself for Holy Communion until she takes "the necessary steps for amendment of her life which would include a public repudiation of her previous efforts and actions in support of laws and policies sanctioning abortion."

Sebelius is known as an aggressive supporter of radical abortion rights and has vetoed a number of pieces of common-sense legislation over the years that would have reigned in an out-of-control abortion industry in Kansas.

Jim and his wife, Michaeleen, reside in Fredericksburg, Virginia. They have three grown children and ten grandchildren. Jim holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Physics from Manhattan College (Bronx, New York) and a Master of Science in Industrial Administration from Union College (Schenectady, NY). He is a Third Degree member of the Knights of Columbus, Council 7877, Stafford, Virginia.

In his professional career, Jim taught physics at Marymount High School in New York City. He worked 30 years for the IBM Corporation as a research physicist and manager of its corporate new products release and control methodologies. While working for IBM, he published four invention disclosures, received seven company awards, ran numerous corporate-wide task forces, achieved the position of Senior Engineer and was recognized as the corporate expert on the release and control of engineering changes. He retired from IBM in 1993 to devote a full time effort to the pro-life cause.

In his life, Jim also served as president of a Parent Teachers Organization, was guest lecturer in a course on medical ethics at Mt. St. Mary's College in Newburgh, New York and was from 1986 to 1992 an annual guest lecturer in ethics courses at Vassar College in Poughkeepsie, New York. He co-founded and was director of STOPP (Stop Planned Parenthood) from 1986 to 1994. He founded and was president of STOPP International from 1994 to 1998, when it merged into American Life League.

Jim joined the pro-life movement in 1980. Among the honors he received are: the 1984 Dutchess County Right to Life's Pro-Lifer of the Year Award; the 1987 Expectant Mother Care's New York Pro-Life Champion Award; the 1987 Parent's Roundtable's Family Life Award; the 1988 American Life League's Unsung Hero Award; the 1993 distinguished Service to Life award from pro-lifers in Grand Haven, Michigan; and the 1999 Pro-Life Award from Good Counsel Homes.

# JULY AND AUGUST SAINTS

**July 3 - St. Thomas the Apostle** was a Jew and probably a Galilean of humble birth, though not much of his youth is known. St. Thomas is well known because of his disbelief in the risen Christ's appearance to the other apostles. When told of Christ's visit, he responded, "Except I shall see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger in the place of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe." Eight days later, when they were all together and the doors shut, the risen Christ was suddenly in the midst of them, greeting them: "Peace be to you." Then He turned to Thomas and said, "Put in thy finger hither, and see my hands; and bring hither thy hand and put it into my side. And be not faithless, but believing." And Thomas fell at His feet, exclaiming, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus answered, "Because thou hast seen me, Thomas, thou hast believed. Blessed are they that have not seen, and have believed."

**July 6 - St. Maria Goretti**, virgin and martyr, was born in 1890. Her father died at a young age causing great financial distress. Maria's mother struggled to feed her children. On a hot July afternoon in 1902, Maria was accosted by an 18-year old boy, Alexander. She fought him repeating, she would rather be killed than submit to him because it was a sin. Alexander began striking at her with a long dagger. Some 24 hours after the assault, Maria died. Alexander was sentenced to 30 years in prison. He was unrepentant. Then one night, he had a dream in which Maria appeared offering flowers to him. From then on he was a changed man. At the end of 27 years, he was released: his first act was to visit Maria's mother and beg her forgiveness. In 1950, Pope Pius XII canonized Maria Goretti in the piazza of St. Peter's square before the largest crowd ever assembled for a canonization.

**July 31 - St. Ignatius Loyola** was born in 1491 in Spain of a noble family. As a soldier in Spain's army he was severely injured and faced death. But God had plans for him. His recovery was slow, painful and difficult; his time was spent reading books on the Life of Jesus and the Saints. The Saints taught him he had to make a choice between the kingdom of Satan and The Kingdom of God. It is apparent which he chose. His life was one of great achievement and holiness. He was a mystic, poet, author of the "Spiritual Exercises" and founder of the Society of Jesus. In the fifteen years that he directed the order he saw it grow from ten members to one thousand. He died July 31, 1556. He was canonized in 1622. Pope Pius XI declared him the heavenly patron of spiritual exercises and retreats.

**August 4 - St. John Mary Vianney** was born near Lyons, France on May 8, 1786. Because of the French Revolution all religious ceremony had to be held in secret. At the age of 13, John Vianney made his first communion. Five years later he asked his father if he could be a priest. But only when he was 23 years old was he permitted to leave home to attend a "presbytery school". His studies were a source of great difficulty for him. He had little natural aptitude and his only schooling had been a brief period at the village school when he was nine years old. His determination to become a priest prevailed. He was ordained to the priesthood on August 12, 1815. He was sent to the remote and neglected place of Ars to minister to 230 souls. He waged relentless war against blasphemy, profanity and obscenity, and was not afraid to utter from the pulpit the words and expressions that offended God, so there should be no mistake as to what he was talking about. For eight years and more he struggled for a proper observance of Sunday. Above all he set his face against dancing, maintaining that it was of necessity an occasion of sin to those who took part, and even to those who only looked on. In 1824, he opened a free school for girls, run by two young women whom he had sent away to a convent to be trained. *Providence*, a shelter for orphans and other homeless or deserted children was set up.

People from afar began to come to him for advice and confession. From 1830 to 1845 the daily visitors averaged over three hundred. This meant no less than eleven or twelve hours every day in the confessional in the winter, and up to sixteen in the summer. Also, for the last fifteen years of his life he gave an instruction every day in the church at eleven o'clock. Between 1858 and 1859, over 100,000 pilgrims visited Ars. John Mary Vianney became known as "The Cure of Ars." He died on August 4, 1859, and was canonized by Pius XI in 1925. This same pope made him principal patron-saint of the parochial clergy throughout the world in 1929.

**August 14 - St. Maximilian Mary Kolbe** was born on January 17, 1894 in Poland. When he was ten years old he had a vision in which Our Lady held out two crowns, one white, the other red, asking him to choose between them. He took both. At only thirteen years of age he joined the Conventual Franciscans, studied in Poland, was sent to Rome and ordained there on April 28, 1918.

## *"Reverence for Life: Conscience and Faithful Citizenship"*

As we approach the long pre-election season every local Catholic should read and study the Kentucky Bishop's pastoral regarding the sanctity and inviolability of human life. In this pastoral letter the bishops make it clear that abortion and euthanasia are the preeminent human rights issues of our day.

"Catholic social doctrine is not limited to the defense and promotion of economic and political rights; human life issues such as abortion, euthanasia, the death penalty, and the violence of war also fall within the scope of social morality.

In the tragic 1973 *Roe v. Wade* case and in subsequent decisions, the U. S. Supreme Court has created a legal climate of abortion on demand and thus has denied the right to life of the unborn. *Faithful for Life: A Moral Reflection*, our 1995 pastoral statement, analyzed the fallout of pervasive ethical relativism and the ensuing deadly moral blindness generated in the wake of *Roe v. Wade*:

Since the legal floodgates were opened in 1973 by the U.S. Supreme Court's decision in *Roe v. Wade*, an abortion mentality has swept across our land and throughout our culture. The language and mindset of abortion — presented in terms of unlimited choice, privacy, and autonomy — pervade our entertainment, our news, our public policies, and even our private lives. Wrapped so appealingly in the language of self-determination, cloaked so powerfully in the mantle of federal authority, is it any wonder that the logic of *Roe* has been extended to apply beyond the unborn? Is it any wonder that it appears so explicitly in our public and private conversations about euthanasia?

With our fellow bishops we continue to voice our opposition to that morally flawed, unjust, and radical judicial fiat that sanctioned abortion on demand. On the occasion of the 35th anniversary of the *Roe v. Wade* decision, we Catholic bishops of Kentucky are issuing a pastoral letter on the fundamental human rights issue of our day --- the right to life of the unborn. Our pastoral concerns will focus on Church teaching on conscience formation and the moral responsibilities of Catholics as citizens".....

## ***US bishops vote on embryo research***

At a June meeting in Orlando, Florida, US bishops adopted a strong statement of opposition to embryonic stem-cell research.

The bishops gave overwhelming approval to the document on embryonic stem-cell research. The statement said that hopes for a medical breakthrough cannot justify the cavalier disregard for the lives of human embryos. "In fact," the statement argued, "policies undermining our respect for human life can only endanger the vulnerable patients that stem-cell research offers to help. The same ethic that justifies taking some lives to help the patient with Parkinson's or Alzheimer's disease today can be used to sacrifice that very patient tomorrow."

## Democratic Party endorses homosexual marriage

California Supreme Court refuses pleas from attorneys general in 10 states to delay homosexual marriage

On June 3, 2008 the Democratic National Committee issued a [2008 Gay PRIDE proclamation supporting homosexual marriage](#). DNC Chairman Howard Dean and Representatives Barney Frank and Tamm Baldwin released the proclamation.

**Also, in a display of sheer arrogance, the California Supreme Court has refused to delay legalization of homosexual marriage until after the people of California have a chance to vote on the issue in November.** Attorneys general from 10 states asked the activist judges to delay implementing their ruling, citing the millions of dollars in litigation it will cost their respective states and the legal chaos caused by the California Supreme Court.

**These activist judges clearly showed their goal is to force homosexual marriage on every American.** The only way America can protect itself from such radical judges is through an amendment to the U.S. Constitution.

Congressman Paul Broun of Georgia has introduced the Marriage Protection Amendment of 2008 (H.J. RES. 89). This amendment would make marriage legal only between a man and a woman.

## Catholic Priest Speaks at Obama's Church

*Catholic League president Bill Donohue comments on Rev. Michael Pfleger's remarks at Sen. Barack Obama's church that led the Catholic priest to apologize and the Democratic hopeful to renounce them:*

"Most commentators are already focusing on the inappropriateness of the ace-baiting comments by Father Pfleger. More serious is the venue in which he delivered his diatribe and his long-standing ties to Sen. Obama.

Father Pfleger's tirade would be inexcusable anywhere, but it is even more offensive when it happens in a church. It does not matter that it was not his own, nor does it matter that it happened in a church that has a record of allowing demagogues to exploit it. When churches become forums for political rallies, both religion and the First Amendment are corrupted.

"Obama and Pfleger are no strangers. Indeed, when Obama was in the state senate in Illinois, he conveniently arranged for Father Pfleger's St. Sabina's Church to receive state monies for its social programs. He is noted for the "Militia of Mary Immaculate" which received the blessing of successive popes. Through the press he was able to publish "The Knight of the Immaculata," the bulletin of his militia which was published in a million copies in many languages. At the outbreak of World War II, Maximilian was in Poland and was arrested by the Germans. He was eventually sent to Auschwitz. He was imprisoned in Block 14. It was customary that if prisoners escaped, ten men were selected from the Block to be executed. One of the ten chosen was the father of a family. Maximilian, who had not been chosen for execution, offered himself in place of the man with a family. He was placed in solitary confinement and left to starve to death. After ten days, he was killed by injection on August 14, 1941. He was canonized on October 10, 1982.

### August 23 - St. Rose of Lima

was born in Peru in 1586. In her growing up years she took St. Catherine of Sienna as her model. Hearing others frequently commenting on her beauty and fearing it would be an occasion of temptation to anyone, she rubbed her face with pepper, in order to disfigure her skin with blotches. Because of her parents' unsuccessful mining venture, Rose worked all day in gardens and late at night mending clothes to help with their necessities. After ten years of unsuccessful attempts by her parents to induce Rose to marry, she strengthened herself by taking a vow of virginity. Then joining the Third Order of St. Dominic, she chose to live in a little hut and became practically a recluse. She wore a circlet of thin silver on her head studded with sharp needles, like a crown of thorns. When stricken by her long and painful last illness her prayer was, "Lord, increase my sufferings and with them increase Thy love in my heart." She died on August 24, 1617 at the age of 31. She was canonized by Pope Clement X in 1671.

# Planned Parenthood's Obscene Profits

In April, the annual report for Planned Parenthood Federation of America revealed that the abortion giant had a total income of \$1.02 billion -- with reported profits of nearly \$115 million. Taxpayers kick in more than \$336 million worth of government grants and contracts at both the state and federal levels. That's a third of Planned Parenthood's budget.

And what market-distorting results do we get for those government incentives? In 2006 alone: 289,750 abortions.

Oil execs, tobacco execs, banking execs, pharmaceutical company execs and baseball players have all been hauled up before Congress for highly publicized whippings by crusading lawmakers. But the executives of Planned Parenthood have escaped government scrutiny and public accountability for their predatory behavior, dangerous medical practices, deception and deadly windfall.

In Washington, D.C., the family of 13-year-old Shantese Butler filed a \$50 million suit against Planned Parenthood after a botched abortion left the girl permanently injured and infertile. Students for Life of America reports that Shantese was left with "severe abdominal bleeding, severe vaginal injury, severe injury to the cervix, significant uterine perforation and a small bowel tear." In addition, parts of the unborn child were found inside Shantese's abdomen.

In Nebraska, Planned Parenthood refused to disclose the terms of a settlement with another victim whose botched abortion resulted in a perforated uterus, massive blood loss, an emergency hysterectomy, permanent infertility, seizures, and lifelong pain and suffering. According to the suit obtained by Life News, the woman instructed the abortionist and his assistants to stop, but was told: "We can't stop." The Planned Parenthood employees held her down to complete the procedure.

Where's the subpoena-wielding Henry Waxman? Can Arlen Specter spare a moment from investigating the New England Patriots to probe Planned Parenthood's efforts to advise underage teens on how to circumvent parental notification laws to secretly obtain RU-486, the abortion drug cocktail? Where is the concern for the women and children who were mistreated by Planned Parenthood clinics in Kansas, where Johnson County District Attorney Phill Kline has filed a 107-count criminal complaint against the abortion racket, with charges ranging from falsifying documents to performing illegal late-term abortions?

And where are Nancy Pelosi and the For The Children brigade to investigate the shocking evidence of Planned Parenthood's nefariousness exposed by undercover student journalist Lila Rose?

Last year, Rose caught a Planned Parenthood official encouraging a female minor to evade statutory rape laws in order to obtain an abortion in California. In February, Rose released undercover tapes of her discussion with an Idaho Planned Parenthood official eager to accept money from a racist donor who wanted his funds earmarked for aborting black babies. In April, she released video of clinic officials in New Mexico and Oklahoma willing to take money from a blatantly racist donor. One Planned Parenthood staffer admits that "for whatever reason, we'll accept the money."

For whatever reason, Washington has turned a blind bipartisan eye to this bloody, government-funded business -- and pro-life, limited-government conservatives in the Beltway have gone along with subsidizing it. "Obscene profits," indeed.

# Assisted Suicide & the Oregon "Health" Plan

More news of the insidious nature of assisted suicide in Oregon was revealed in Eugene, Oregon's daily newspaper, the *Register-Guard*. Pro-life citizens have warned for years that assisted suicide would become a means of cost containment. This latest revelation is yet another confirmation of that warning.

Last month, Barbara Wagner, a 64-year-old retired school bus driver, found out that her cancer, which had been in remission for two years, had come back. After her doctor prescribed a cancer drug that could slow the cancer growth and extend her life, Wagner was notified that the Oregon Health Plan wouldn't cover her prescription, but that it would cover assisted suicide.

**"To say to someone, we'll pay for you to die, but not pay for you to live, it's cruel," she said. The senior medical director of the company that administers the Oregon Health Plan justified the decision to pay for assisted suicide, but not pay for treatment. He explained that assisted suicide could be considered a "comfort care measure" and that it was necessary "to point out the options available" under the Oregon Health Plan.**

Its advocates say that Oregon's assisted-suicide law is working well. How in the world could anyone consider the cruelty that Barbara Wagner experienced to be evidence that all is working well? There is a happy ending to this story, though. After hearing about her plight, a representative of the pharmaceutical company that manufactures the cancer drug Wagner needed called her and told her that it would provide the medicine free of charge. As you are reading this, those same assisted-suicide activists who say Oregon's law is working well are feverishly working to promote their agenda throughout the country. The abortion front is the battle to save pre-born life; the assisted-suicide & euthanasia front is the battle to save YOUR life.

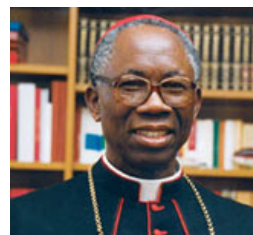

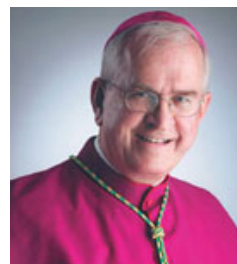
